All applicants must be a member in good standing with the State Bar of Georgia or be in good standing of another state's bar association that is eligible for reciprocity admittance to the State Bar of Georgia; and be admitted to practice before the Georgia Supreme Court and Court of Appeals. Although current Georgia bar members with experience are preferred, upcoming law school graduates who will be taking the Georgia bar exam in February or July, 2024 will be considered. All candidates are subject to a background check. Applicants selected for hire will be subject to fingerprinting, a criminal history background check, a motor vehicle driver's history check and pre-employment drug screening; employment is contingent upon the completion and satisfactory results of each investigation. This position is subject to employment verification using the Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System.
